Solidarity with South Sudan is building the capacity of South Sudanese as teachers, nurses and midwives. 29/39 new nurses and midwives graduated with distinction in 2018. The rest received upper credits. Over 80% of all graduates are employed. South Sudan is a country engulfed in civil war. Many of the gains made since independence in 2011 have been destroyed. 4 million people are internally displaced and another 2 million have fled the country. Only 10% of women give birth with a healthcare attendant. 15% of children die before age 5.
