South Sudan is a country engulfed in civil war. Many of the gains made since independence in 2011 have been destroyed. 4 million people are internally displaced and another 2 million have fled the country. Only 10% of women give birth with a healthcare attendant. 15% of children die before age 5.

Solidarity with South Sudan is building the capacity of South Sudanese as teachers, nurses and midwives. Nearly half of all registered nurses and midwives in the country have been trained by Solidarity, nearly 150 since 2011.
