South Sudan is a country engulfed in civil war. Many of the gains made since independence in 2011 have been destroyed. Four million people are internally displaced, and another 2 million have fled the country. Only 10% of women give birth with a healthcare attendant. Fifteen percent of children die before age 5. Solidarity with South Sudan is building the capacity of South Sudanese as teachers, nurses and midwives. Nearly half of all registered nurses and midwives in the country have been trained by Solidarity, 225 since 2011.

What better gift can be given than training health care professionals in the poorest and newest country of our world!
