Solidarity with South Sudan is building the capacity of South Sudanese as teachers, nurses and midwives. There is a need for 26,000 teachers. More than 500 new teachers have graduated from the Solidarity Teacher Training College since 2013.

South Sudan is a country engulfed in civil war. Many of the gains made since independence in 2011 have been destroyed. Four million people are internally displaced, and another 2 million have fled the country. Over 70% of children are not in school or do not have a teacher in a classroom.
